Water Projects



At Zumar Foundation, we strove to give Needy communities safe access to clean water.

Highlights

- We refurbished broken water systems; constructed handpump water wells and developed Artesian boreholes powered by solar system.
- To ensure the long-term sustainability of Water facilities, we trained 125 Water Management Committees to maintain and repair water points.

356,214 People accessed drinking safe and clean water.
