Zumar Foundation works at Relief, Education and Social Development, Water Projects, Seasonal Programs and Health Promotion.

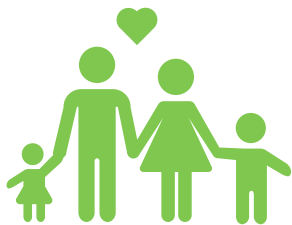
However, referring to our strategy plan, we implemented distinguished projects of relief, water projects and seasonal programs.

Sustainable Infrastructured

in one-year operation, Zumar Foundation already implemented sustainable infrastructure development during its humanitarian intervention among its areas of jurisdiction in Uganda to improve environmental conditions and people's health and quality of life. Contracted three sustainable boreholes in Luwero and Buikwe Districts of central region of Uganda. Prior to their construction hydrogeological surveys is conducted and local authorities consulted to establish the location of sustainable, high yielding aquifers with good quality water.

Therefore, it is estimated that each borehole provides water to at least 1,000 households (7,000 Individuals). As a result, the refurbished one and three new boreholes uses by 28,000 individuals.



Ramadan Food Parcel Relief

Every Ramadan, Zumar Foundation provides food parcels containing essential items such as oil, flour and dates to families in need across some districts in Uganda.

The food parcels allow them to be better prepared for the month of Ramadan, easing their worries about how to access food with which to start and end their fast.

Our annual Ramadan campaign enables people to share the blessings of the holy month with families in Uganda. The donations we received last year alone allowed us provide food to more than 4,000 people in 4 districts (Kampala, Wakiso, Luwero and Buikwe) during Ramadan.



COVID-19 Relief

As a result of COVID-19 pandemic, a relief food distribution campaign started. Zumar Foundation's Coronavirus Response Team at the forefront specified on the following measures; that food was to be distributed primarily to the urban poor who are affected by the nationwide lockdown; as a matter of urgency, priority was given to the urban groups in the central region (Capital - Kampala and Wakiso district). More than 600 families received this food distribution aid during lockdowns.



Qurban Project

- Qurban as referred to Islamic law, is the ritual sacrifice of a livestock animal during Eid al-Adha. Muslims sacrifice livestock during the Eid al-Adha and our foundation's project is to distribute meat of sacrificial animal in Uganda to the needy people and poor people.

This year, Zumar Foundation with partnership of Turkish Diyanet Foundation slaughtered 1000 cows that benefited more than 350,000 people in 16 districts in Uganda during Aid adha festivals.
